### **BACK TO BLACKOUT**

**18x24** JULY 2025

"Back to Blackout" is a bold yet intimate portrayal of Amy Winehouse, captured in stark grayscale against a striking blood-red backdrop. Her piercing gaze, captured in contrast and shadow, confronts the viewer with a quiet intensity—one that speaks to both her brilliance and the weight she carried. The tattooed arm, her iconic winged eyeliner, and tousled hair are rendered with sharp definition, yet the shadows surrounding her speak louder than the light. The composition is cinematic, almost frozen in a reflective moment—somewhere between seduction and sorrow. The red background bleeds into the scene like emotion itself, symbolic of love, pain, and vulnerability that often fueled Amy's music This piece means more to me than just a tribute—it's a visual representation of the fragile balance between art and anguish. Amy Winehouse embodied unapologetic talent, but also the danger of being consumed by your own intensity. In painting her, I felt like I was preserving that balance—celebrating her raw authenticity while acknowledging the cost of her genius."Back to Blackout" reminds me of the responsibility we carry as artists—to be real, to be honest, and to protect our peace while sharing our truth. It's a powerful piece for me personally—one that continues to inspire reflection, empathy, and deep respect for the souls who give us everything through their art.



### **GUILT DRIP 18×24** JUNE 2025

"Guilt Drip" captures the fierce beauty of a roaring tiger, frozen in black-and-white contrast with a jarring twist — gold paint dripping from its mouth like blood turned treasure. This isn't just a portrait of a predator; it's a reflection of inner conflict. The tiger's powerful expression, layered in stark shadows and bold outlines, becomes a metaphor for strength compromised by conscience — the proud roar of dominance tainted by the weight of remorse. The gold suggests value, but also excess, ego, and temptation. It raises a question: what have we sacrificed to get where we are, and was it worth it? This piece transforms a symbol of fearlessness into a visual confession. Guilt Drip reminds me that even the boldest among us wrestle with emotion, memory, and morality. It's a confrontation between pride and pain, and the realization that power doesn't always mean peace. This piece holds space for both the predator and the person inside me — the part that roars, and the part that bleeds.



### BROOKLYN BRUSH STROKES

**16x20** MAY 2025



The minimalist tones reflect both the rawness and clarity of his voice in hip-hop culture, while the stylized smoke swirling from his cigar adds movement, tension, and personality. Biggie's gaze—serious, unshaken, and larger-than-life—anchors the piece in attitude and legacy. The painting merges urban grit with emotional reverence, using contrast and negative space to command attention and respect. This piece is more than a portrait—it's a salute to vision, hustle, and voice. Biggie represents the power of storytelling, resilience, and staying true to your roots. For me, painting this piece was a way of connecting to the roots of hip-hop culture that have shaped my art and my creative purpose. ### MARILYN IN THE MIRROR

'Marilyn in the Mirror' captures the haunting duality of a global icon. This monochromatic portrait, punctuated by her signature red lips, plays with contrast and shadow to reflect both the beauty and burden Marilyn carried. Her hand pressed softly to her face adds a quiet, introspective mood — like she's caught mid-thought in a rare moment of solitude, peering back at herself beyond the spotlight. The fragmented grayscale technique gives the image a mirrored, almost ghostly quality. It feels like you're witnessing both Marilyn the myth and Norma Jeane the woman — layered, complex, and suspended in reflection. This piece is a love letter to the humanity behind the glamor. Marilyn in the Mirror is a reminder that even the most adored figures in history wrestle with identity, loneliness, and vulnerability. As an artist, I see this painting as a representation of the masks we wear, the sides of ourselves we choose to show or hide — especially in public or creative spaces. It holds space for the contrast between how we're seen and how we truly feel inside.



### GRAFFITI GOSPEL 16x20x1 MAY 2025

"Graffiti Gospel" is a bold and raw acrylic portrait that pays tribute to the legacy of Tupac Shakur — not only as a rapper, but as a revolutionary voice, poet, and prophet of the streets. The vibrant yellow backdrop symbolizes hope and illumination, while the red hair nods to rebellion, passion, and individuality. His eyes, glazed and turned upward, represent transcendence, as though he's no longer confined to our physical world but still very much present in soul and spirit. The dripping letters forming his name blur the lines between identity and legacy — as if Tupac's essence is seeping into everything around us. This piece is a personal reminder that art, like Tupac's words, can be loud, unfiltered, and deeply spiritual. Graffiti Gospel is my way of merging street art with sacred message — a visual sermon born from pain, protest, and power. It's about honoring the raw truth and emotion Tupac carried in his music, and channeling that same energy into personal creative expression. For me, this painting is a statement of resilience, rebellion, and remembrance. It's a voice that refuses to be silenced.



### THE MELTDOWN 18x24 APRIL 2025

"The Meltdown" is a vibrant yet unsettling exploration of emotional contrast and psychological overload. Using bright yellows and bold blues to symbolize happiness and calm, the work is intentionally disrupted by dripping black paint, chaotic smiles, and crossed-out eyes—visual metaphors for emotional distortion, burnout, and the fragility of mental stability. The smiling faces are not all what they seem—some are melting, others crossed out, some even crying black tears—challenging the viewer to look beyond surface-level emotion and consider what lies beneath curated appearances. The drips and smears amplify the idea of a breakdown—literal and emotional. Through this piece I was able to confront the disconnect between how I was perceived and how I truly felt. Every face, every drip, every distorted smile captures that tension between joy and exhaustion."The Meltdown" is a reminder to acknowledge our emotions, honor our limits, and accept that it's okay to not be okay. It's a visual diary entry—raw, loud, and honest—and one of the most meaningful pieces I've ever created.



### SIX PACK: VOLUME 2 | SIZZLE








